



Autumn Immersion Certification Program

2017

The NWED Autumn Immersion program allows candidates to combine all program elements (internship, content modules, and reflections) into a shorter, more intense experience. It is designed for individuals who are not available to do previous work before September. It is recommended for candidates who have no other commitments and can devote significant time to NWED program requirements.

Candidates will be hosted by a cooperating teacher, who acts as their mentor, a NWED field supervisor. They are required to have full control of the classroom for at least 8 weeks inside of their 450 hour internship. Although typically candidates complete in the spring, many will require more time to complete program components.

Program timeline:

- Applications accepted: January 1- June 1st
- Applicant selection and notification: June 10th
- Program orientation: August 23rd
- Candidates enter classroom placement: September
- Expected exit: February 2018*

Endorsement areas for this program: elementary, English, math, and world languages.

Cost: \$9,900

Candidates must have already earned a four-year degree from an accredited college or university to qualify for this program.

*Completion is dependent on the fulfillment of required hours, competencies, reflections, and evaluations.
